

## Gun Match Rules

### Rules for 22 200yd match

This is an informal match fired at 200 yards on the NRA High Power 600 Yard Target reduced for 200 yards. The target's 5 ring, the outermost scoring ring, is 19.75" across. The 7 ring is the outermost scoring ring in the target black and is 11.75" across. The 10 ring and X ring span 3.75" and 1.75" respectively. Only rifles chambered for the 22 Long Rifle cartridge will be allowed. Any sight, iron or optical, may be used. Firing may be from either the club's firing benches or prone. Any benchrest, sandbag, bipod or sling may be used. The match will consist of a 10 minute sighting period with an unlimited number of sighting shots allowed. No sighting shots will be allowed after this period. Following the sighting period 20 shots for record will be fired in a 20 minute time limit. Scoring will be performed by competitors following each 20 round string. Matches will consist of three to five record targets based on the desires of the competitors. The sighting period will begin at 9:00 AM and the entry fee is \$10.00. The overall high score will be recognized along with the high score for equipment and position divisions but no awards will be given.
